**SUBJECT: APPLICATION FOR MASTER IN PUBLIC ADMINISTRATION [MPA] 2008 AND MASTER
IN PUBLIC POLICY [MPP] 2008 AT THE NATIONAL UNIVERSITY OF SINGAPORE**

- 1.0 The Lee Yew School of Public Policy [LKYSPP] at the national university of Singapore [NUS] is seeking information for potential serving officers to pursue one of the above captioned Masters programmes for the tertiary year 2008.
- 2.0 The LKYSPP has informed that scholarships are available for both the programmes, which will be on a competitive basis. The applications received from the Fiji Government will be assessed in terms of an applicant's qualifications, work experience, interview and other deciding factors for provision of funding/scholarship to ensure the selection of most suitable candidates.
- 3.0 The MPA and MPP programmes will commence from July, 2008 and the application deadline to the LKYSPP for the two programmes is 31st January, 2008. However, the duly completed application forms, including TNA & selection forms with other relevant documents should reach the Center for Training Division of the PSC of the agencies covering memorandum **no later than the 15th of January, 2008.**
- 4.0 The Permanent Secretaries and Heads of Departments must ensure that the very best candidate is nominated, aligned to the training needs and government's Equal Employment Opportunity Policy and requirements of the LKYSPP [refer to the website www.lkspp.nus.edu.sg] and accordance with the PSC Circular No 45/2005 of 25th October, 2005.
