**CIRCULAR MEMORANDUM**

**To :** Permanent Secretaries and Heads of Departments

**Subject :** **MAXIMIZING THE UTILIZATION OF GOVERNMENT RESOURCES AND LOCAL PRODUCTS**

**1.0** All Permanent Secretaries/Heads of Departments are encouraged to seriously explore ways of maximising the utilisation of government resources and local products.

**2.0 Hiring out Borron House**

The Prime Minister has agreed that options be explored for the hiring out of Borron House to the private sector and other organizations. This will allow for the use of the premises for private functions and for short-term stays. The terms and conditions for the use of the property will be formulated by the Public Service Commission and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and this will be forwarded shortly to all Permanent Secretaries/Heads of Departments. The property which is usually left idle for most parts of the year, should now become an income-generating entity for Government.

**3.0 Use of Local Produce**

In the same manner, all Ministries and Departments are also encouraged to seriously explore ways of utilising local foods. Given the abundance of local fruits and vegetables, all Permanent Secretaries/Heads of Departments must now make a concerted effort to ensure that such products are used by local caterers contracted to provide lunches and morning teas. Government's support for local producers will definitely provide them with the added confidence that they need during these challenging times.
