**Subject:** USE OF LEGAL SERVICES FROM THE  
LAW FIRMS OF MUNRO LEYS AND HOWARDS

**Date:** 30/05/07

- 1.0 Given the need to consolidate Government's position and avoid conflicts of interest, Cabinet has directed that no Government Ministry, Statutory Body or Corporate Entity, it to use the legal services of the Law Firms of Munro Leys and Howards.
- 2.0 Should any Ministry or Statutory Body and Entity find it difficult to acquire legal services in the absence of Munro Leys and Howards then the Attorney -General's Chambers is to be contacted which would refer them to other legal services providers.
- 3.0 It shall be the responsibility of each line Ministry to ensure that this Cabinet directive is adhered to. In this respect an audit shall be carried out on a quarterly basis. Failure to comply with this requirement will render addressees liable for disciplinary action.
- 4.0 Please bring this Circular to the attention of all officers in your Ministry/Departments who are involved in the provision and procurement of legal services.
