**Subject:** BUS OWNERS PROTEST

- 1.0 This circular information is issued to guide you during the bus owner's protest against Government's offer of a 10% subsidy towards fuel costs.
- 2.0 Please note that all civil servants are requested to report to work as normal but for those of you who cannot report to your office are required to avail yourself to the nearest Government Office in your vicinity and offer your assistance.
- 3.0 For all civil servants engaged in emergency and essential services and their being at work is hampered by this standoff, please make necessary arrangements with your Ministry for transportation purpose.
- 4.0 For civil servants excluding those in the emergency and essential services who are not able to make it to work, nor render their services to their nearest government offices will be granted duty leave during the duration of their absence.
