Subject: **COUNTRY REPORTS AND STATEMENTS**

- 1.0 With effect, from the date of this circular, all country reports and statements that are to be made by officers, who are on assignment or training overseas, must be **endorsed by the Prime Minister**.
 - 2.0 Officers must be reminded that these reports and statements must be in agreement with Government's plans and agenda.
 - 3.0 Furthermore, while civil servants are on official duty in a foreign country, they must realize that they are also playing an ambassadorial role, and must therefore comply with the responsibilities of the position.
 - 4.0 For this reason, all documents that will be presented and statements that are to be made at any overseas forum, must be aligned to the vision of Government, and must receive prior endorsement by the Prime Minister.
