



PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

2010 PRE-SERVICE SCHOLARSHIPS AWARD

Applications are invited for the PSC Pre-Service Scholarships tenable in 2010.

Civil Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Mechanical Engineering

Applicants must note the following minimum requirements:

- Applicants must be Fiji Citizens.
- Applicants must be under 35 years of age or be 35 years of age by 1st January 2010;
- Students already on full scholarship and studying on Fiji Government awards, Student Loan Scheme, Fijian Affairs (except Foundation) and Multi Ethnic Affairs Scholarships will **NOT** be considered;
- Applications from employees in the private sector **MUST** include their employer's recommendations;
- Civil Servants are **NOT** eligible to apply for this Scholarship.
- Applicants applying for scholarships should lodge separate applications for admission to the respective Tertiary Institutions of their choice of study in 2010.

[1] INSTITUTIONS AND FIELDS OF STUDIES :

[A] UNIVERSITY OF THE SOUTH PACIFIC

- Students currently in the **Foundation Year or Degree programmes with 'B' average must** submit their Semester I & II results as soon as they are released. Applications will **not be considered if semesters I & II results are not provided.**
- Form VII** with **2008 FSLC marks of 270 and above** are eligible to apply.

- Students currently in the **Foundation Year or Degree programmes with 'B' average must** submit their Semester I & II results as soon as they are released. Applications will **not be considered if semesters I & II results are not provided.**
- Form VII** with **2008 FSLC marks of 280 and above** are eligible to apply.

[C] FIJI INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY

- Students currently in the **Foundation Year or Degree programmes with 'B' average must** submit their Semester I & II results as soon as they are released. Applications will **not be considered if semesters I & II results are not provided.**
- Form VII** with **2008 FSLC marks of 250 and above** are eligible to apply.

viii. Bachelor of Commerce

Accounting, Economics, Human Resource Management & Industrial Relations, Marketing, Information Systems

ix. Diploma Programmes

- Students who are currently in Form VII with 2008 FSLC marks of 250 and above & continuing students are eligible to apply.
- Hospitality Operations, Civil Engineering, Marine Engineering, Quantity Survey, Land Surveying, Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Building

x. Advanced Diploma

- Students who have graduated from Diploma programme are eligible to apply.

[D] UNIVERSITY OF FIJI

- Students currently in the **Foundation Year or Degree programmes with 'B' average must** submit their Semester I & II results as soon as they are released. Applications will **not be considered if semesters I & II results are not provided.**
- Form VII** with **2008 FSLC marks of 250 and above** are eligible to apply.

xi. Bachelor of Arts (BA)

Language and Literature, Fijian Language, Language and Literature/Hindi Language

xii. Bachelor of Commerce (BCom)

Accounting/Economics, Accounting/Management, Management/Economics, Information Technology/Accounting

xiii. MBBS [UMANAND PRASAD SCHOOL OF MEDICINE]

- Students currently in the **Foundation Science Year or continuing programmes with 'B' average must** submit their Semester I & II results as soon as they are released. Applications will **not be considered if semesters I & II results are not provided.**
- Form VII** with **2008 FSLC marks of 270 and above** are eligible to apply.
